

Run The Loop Prize Regulations

OPEN & ELITE RACE PRIZES

- All races will be conducted under standard rules of running. No jostling, obstruction, or use of force will be permitted.
- Elite prize money, including the RunDNA 1 km prizes, is only available to athletes competing in the Elite Men's and Elite Women's races.
- To be eligible for the RunDNA 1 km prize, the athlete must be the first to pass the designated 1 km mark and must continue the race with a bona fide effort to finish.
- If the result at the 1 km mark appears to be a draw, the prize will be awarded to the athlete who records the faster overall finishing time.
- Course record bonuses will only be awarded to the first athlete to cross the finish line under the current record time for their category.

UNDER 18 (U18) PRIZES

- U18 results will be determined purely on time, regardless of race. As a result, the U18 winner may come from any race on the program.
- Athletes are eligible to win both Elite prizes and U18 prizes if they are competing in an Elite race and meet the age criteria.
- To be eligible for U18 prizes, an athlete must be under 18 years of age on the date of competition.

MASTERS (O35 & O55) PRIZES

- Masters prizes are only available to athletes competing in the designated Masters races.
- To be eligible, athletes must be 35 years or older (O35) or 55 years or older (O55) on the day of competition.
- Athletes competing in Open or Elite races are not eligible for Masters prizes.

DISPUTES

- Any disputes or queries relating to results or prize eligibility must be made to the Event Manager, whose decision will be final.
